Position Overview

This position works closely with other members of their team, as well as their Crew Leader and Production Manager.

Essential Responsibilities for Irrigation Technicians

- Operating and understanding all tools and machinery used by our production team. Possibly operating non-CDL automatic and stick-shift vehicles, including vans, dump trucks, and truck/trailer combinations.
- Cleaning and maintaining tools and equipment. Being responsible for the security and well-being of the tools and equipment assigned to the team.
- Following all company policies and procedures outlined within the Employee Handbook.
- Aiding in snow removal, if called upon.
- Completing any other duties, as assigned.
